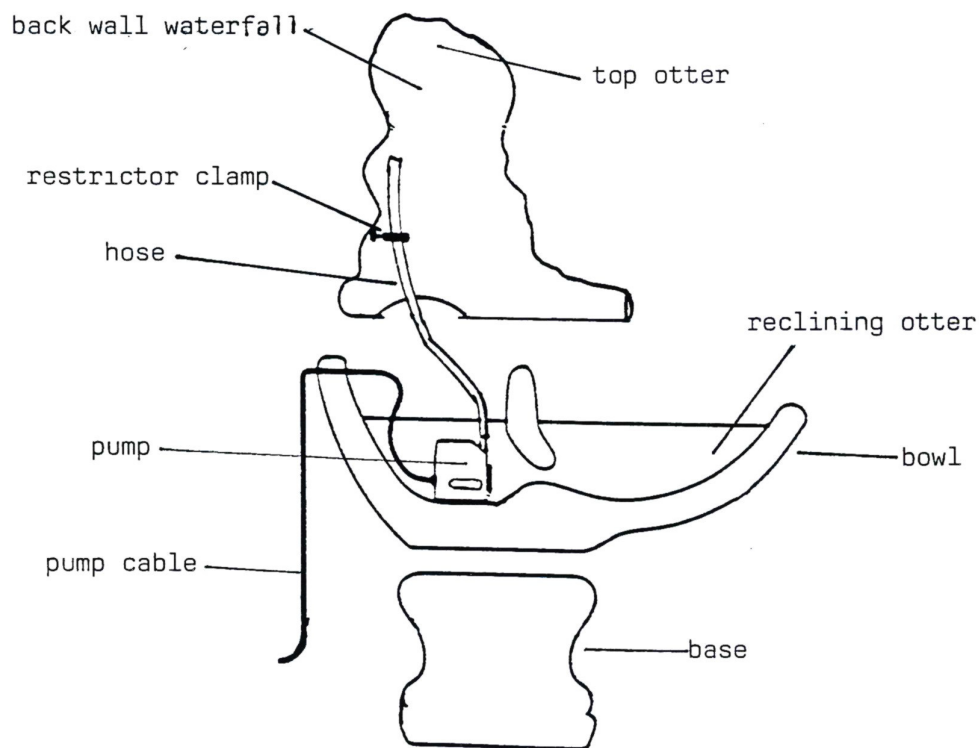


## Otter Playground Fountain 4487F5

1. Set the bowl on the base in a firm and level position. For added stability or balance, cut the mastic strip as required and place between bowl and base.
2. Carefully push the plastic tubing over the pump outlet and slide the restrictor clamp half-way down the plastic tubing. Place the pump into the pump chamber.
3. Whilst holding the back wall waterfall into position, push the plastic tubing over the copper tube cast into the back of it. This is often a two-person job. Make sure that the fountain does not slide as this can cause paint damage.
4. Fill the bowl with water from a bucket or hose. To prevent the growth of unsightly algae, add Henri Studio water Clarifier as directed.
5. Connect the pump to your electricity supply. See page 18 of fact book for details.
6. Adjust the flow of water as required using the restrictor clamp.
7. When happy with water flow, place otters in position. Use mastic strip if required.



### **Important Winter Care**

**Do not allow water to collect and freeze in fountain bowl(s) or shell. Do not allow fountain to sit in a pool of ice. Disassemble entire fountain and pump and store indoors during the winter season.**

If you cannot store your fountain indoors during the winter season, you must at least protect it from ice collection or exposure. "How" to protect your fountain during the winter: First remove the statue and pump, storing them inside if possible. Next locate the drain plug on the underside of the bowl(s) or shell. Remove the drain plug to drain any water 'trapped' between the walls of the bowl(s) or shell. Then fill the bowl(s) or shell with an absorbent material such as burlap, blanket, etc. Finally cover the entire fountain with a Henri Fountain cover. Should condensation droplets form on the inside of the cover, they will be absorbed by the material. By following these simple and sensible precautions during the winter season, you will protect your fountain for years of enjoyment.
